TRANSFER--ANOTHER COMMERCIAL OR PUBLIC SCHOOL PROGRAM:

Students **may transfer** from an approved **commercial driving school** driver's education program or an approved **public school** driver's education program and be allowed to **receive credit for the hours completed at that school.**

- For example, if a student completes **10-2 hour sessions of classroom** (20 classroom hours) and **3-2 hour sessions of in-car sessions** (6 hours), he would receive credit for **20 classroom hours** and **3 hours of in-car driving & 3 hours of observation.**
- All Star** would then be able to **complete** the remaining required **12 hours of classroom** and **4 hours of in-car driving & 4 hours of observation.**
- All Star** would need to receive a **Texas Education Agency form DL964** indicating the hours **eligible for transfer** and a **copy of the curriculum** from the transferring school. (In order to know which classroom or in-car hours to complete.)
- Tuition** would be **prorated** for the **uncompleted hours** from the transferring school based on the **hourly rate of All Star.** There is also an additional **\$50.00 transfer fee.**
- Paperwork **cannot** be released until **all hours have been completed** and the **TEA DL964** received by **All Star.**

TRANSFER--PARENT TAUGHT PROGRAM:

Students **may transfer:**

- All** of the **classroom phase** (total of 32 classroom hours) from parent taught program. or
- All** of the **in-car phase of driver's education** (total of 14 in-car hours –7 driving & 7 in observation) from a parent taught program.
- Individual hours cannot be transferred. Each phase must be completed under one instructor.**
- All Star** must receive a **Texas Department of Public Safety form DL964PT** transfer indicating the which phase of driver's education the student was transferring (either classroom or in-car phase). A parent may substitute a copy of the student's classroom or driving log signed by the parent taught instructor.
- Tuition for **classroom phase is \$225.00 or \$255.00 with permit service.**
- Tuition for **in-car phase is \$315.00 (permit service is not available)**
- Paperwork cannot be released until all hours have been completed and the TDPS form DL964PT or parent taught instructor's log has been received.

NOTE:

If there is a desire to change programs prior to the completion of either phase of classroom or in-car, **all previous education or training hours (including obtaining a new instructional permit and a new six months waiting period) must be repeated.**
